5 Year Warranty

The external castings on Stanley stoves are covered by warranty for up to 5 years. Ceramic glass is covered against thermal breakage for 3 years. Refractory materials, rope seals, glass seals, cement seals, the surface finish on seno models, grates and fire bars are covered under a standard 1 year warranty.

High Chromium castings

The fire box of Stanley stoves are manufactured using high chromium castings. Altering the composition to include 14-17% chromium significantly changes the properties of the cast iron. High chromium iron has a higher melting point allowing it to withstand higher firebox temperatures and making it more resistant to warping. Smokeless fuels such as anthracite burn at much higher temperatures than coal or wood and can reduce the lifespan of standard grates and internal castings without a high chromium content.

Superior enamel grade

A special enamel formulation has been developed with our raw material suppliers over many years of cooperation, to provide a high gloss finish that gives a beautiful longer lasting shine to Stanley stoves.

High efficiency ratings

Stanley stoves have been third party approved to the BS EN 13240 (European Standard) for roomheaters fired by solid fuel, and yield efficiencies of up to 79%.

Low Co2 emissions

Stanley stoves incorporate the latest clean-burn technology to deliver the most efficient use of energy and to protect the environment from harmful fumes. Fresh air is carefully channelled below, around and above the fire box, to create the optimum conditions for combustion. Any solid particles and volatile gasses produced from the fire are re-ignited and burnt off, before they can enter the atmosphere. This process not only guarantees that you achieve the maximum heat output from your chosen fuel, but also helps to keep the window clean and clear.
